Moët et Chandon Imperial Brut N/V

Mellow and harmonious with well developed flavours and a persistent mousse.

Moët et Chandon Nectar N/V

Nectar Impérial is a champagne to please the senses. The assemblage is built around the structure of the Pinot Noir : supple and smooth. Nectar Impérial is both a refined and sophisticated wine whose richness turns into sensuality.

Methode Cap Classique and Sparkling Wine

Pongracz Brut N/V -

It has good mousse and persistent bead. Classical yeast and biscuit character on the nose with a full fruit and acid balance on the palate which lingers.

Bottle matured on lees. This bottle fermented (MCC) sparkling wine, made from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay has an elegant, biscuity bouquet, with yeasty lees-creaminess and fine, persistent bubbles.

Robertson Light - *Robertson*

A refreshing, crisp, lighter style of wine with hints of freshly cut grass and green pepper. Low in alcohol and contains fewer kilojoules.

Durbanville Hills - *Durbanville*

Seamlessly layered flavours ranging from tropical fruit to fig, lime, guava and gooseberry, leading up to a crisp finish.

Fort Simon - *Stellenbosch*

Bright in colour, tropical fruit on the nose, packed with gooseberry, peach, mango, litchi, guava and quince flavour. Well balanced on the palate with a long, lingering fruity aftertaste.

R148

Boschendal 1685 (Grande Vin Blanc) - *Franschhoek*

An interesting blend of 92% Sauvignon Blanc and 8% Semillon. This wine has abundant tropical fruit and asparagus flavours on the nose, with a steely raciness, reflecting the wines superior fruit quality. A wine to be enjoyed with fish or chicken and will also complement dishes with rich, creamy sauces.

Paul Cluver - *Elgin*

The palate is complex with all the aromas from the nose coming through and with a distinct mineral aftertaste. The mid palate is quite broad and complex.

Verglegen - *Stellenbosch*

Pale straw in colour, the nose shows passion fruit, green fig, guava and lemon/grapefruit.

Stenberg - *Constantia*

Grassiness and gooseberry overtones with a gentle scent of tropical fruit. This Sauvignon Blanc reflects the fresh, flinty and full bodied characteristics of grass, peppers and fruit. A firm and lasting aftertaste.

Nederburg Manor House - *Paarl*

Passion fruit, asparagus and green figs with a vibrant acidity and an underlying trace of subtle sweetness rounding off the palate.

Warwick Professor Black - *Stellenbosch*

Well-defined Sauvignon Blanc with lovely green fig and gooseberry freshness.

Regularly and reliably achieves a smooth balance between concentrated lemon-lime fruit character that harmonises with subtle toasty flavours of French oak.

Graham Beck Waterside - *Robertson*

Upfront tropical fruit, ripe pineapple, melon, peaches and honeysuckle flavours on the nose. Full and creamy palate with layers of ripe tropical fruit and spices.

Fat Bastard - *Robertson*

R138

Full, rich and ripe with some pretty serious oak treatment. Displays all of the qualities of its Fresh big brother.

Boschendal 1685 - *Franschhoek*

R158

Made 100% from Chardonnay grapes. After hand-harvesting the grapes, 70% of the wine is fermented and matured in French oak barrels for 8 months. This complex wine has an elegant depth and a nutty character that Chardonnay lovers so enjoy. Excellent with soft cheeses.

Fort Simon - *Stellenbosch*

R175

Herbaceous entree, fruity citrus with soft touches of mint toffee, butterscotch, apricot and caramel. Well balanced and crisp with soft wood nuances.

Glen Carlou - *Paarl*

R198

Baked pear with gorgeous lime-driven fruit mid-palate, showy and succulent. Shades of both French oak and American oak enhance this popular fine wine.

Chenin Blanc

Spier - *Stellenbosch*

R89

The wine shows aromas of guava and tropical fruit, with subtle hints of kiwi fruit. A well-balanced palate of lively fruit shows firm acidity and a long, mouth-watering finish.

Ken Forrester Petit Chenin - *Stellenbosch*

R92

A youthful wine showing green apple, honeysuckle fruit, fresh ripe melon with a mellow, round and mild palate and refreshingly long finish.

Boschendal - *Franschhoek*

R98

A classy uncomplicated unwooded wine packed with ripe melon, peach and passion fruit on the palate that precedes a penetrating fresh finish of pure primary fruit.

White Blends And Other Cultivar

Robertson Beauquette - *Robertson*

Gentle, Muscat-scented semi-sweet white, smooth, subtly spicy palate, good long flavour.

Robertson Pinot Grigio - *Robertson*

Wonderfully pleasant and fresh on the taste with a pale green hue. Tropical fruit flavours of ripe pineapple and melon greet the palate ending with an aftertaste that is well rounded and creamy.

Glen Carlou Tortoise Hill White - *Paarl*

Mixed tropical fruit on the nose with hints of white peach, litchi and cured pineapple. Perfumed floral tones on the palate with lemon and boiled sweets flavour. Long, smooth finish with a full mouthfeel.

Flagstone Noon Gun - *Stellenbosch*

Honeydew melon with slices of paw-paw and a touch of orange peel and a sprinkle of cinnamon on the nose. Sweet fruit with a creamy sensation on the palate and a zesty crisp lingering finish.

R115

Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc - *Constantia*

Gentle, Muscat-scented semi-sweet white, smooth, subtly spicy palate, good long flavour.

R118

Zevenwacht Tin Mine White - *Stellenbosch*

Ripe and exotic, a distinctive, spicy wine that is rich and subtly oaked. The Chardonnay gives superb lime-citrus flavours and the Viognier lends a delicate perfume of dried peaches and apricots.

Boschendal 1685 Chardonnay Pinot Noir - *Franschhoek*

Hints of tropical fruit, pineapple and mango on the palate give way to more powerful spicy fruit flavours and a persistent, lingering aftertaste. An excellent compliment to poultry and cream-based dishes.

Nederburg - *Paarl*

A lively light to medium-bodied wine with a clean, fruity and refreshing finish.

Boschendal Blanc De Noir - *Franschhoek*

South Africa's original 'Blanc de Noir' style wine since 1981 made exclusively from red grapes. Seductively pink with alluring ripe raspberry and spice and a succulently sweet yet fresh berry finish.

Morgenhof Fantail Rosé - *Stellenbosch*

This salmon pink wine shows flavours of strawberries and raspberries. These flavours follow through onto a juicy palate with a pleasing crisp finish.

Merlot



Robertson - Robertson R32 R95
Punchy plum flavours, touch of oak and velvet textured finish. Medium to full bodied with a delicate wood treatment that does not shield the fruit.

Porcupine Ridge - Franschhoek R43 R125
Full bodied red with coffee, chocolate and spicy vanilla undertones. Elegant and rich with a lengthy finish.

Fort Simon - Stellenbosch R148
Rich, sweet flavours of red and black berries upfront, with whiffs of tobacco and baked sweet potatoes. On the palate, these fruity aromas are carried through with soft, smokey oak nuances for a long lingering aftertaste.

Zevenwacht - Stellenbosch R148
Rich and generous with plush concentrated flavours of plums, chocolate and a combination of red and black cherries. Waves of up front fresh red fruit and hints of herbs cover the palate from start to finish.

Boschendal 1685 - Franschhoek R180
Succulent and smooth with compelling dark berry and fleshy plum flavours perfectly completed by slick underlying spicy wood tones from 12 months maturation in French oak barrels.

Meinert - Stellenbosch R225
An elegant fruity and soft Merlot with as always classical Meinert tones. Excellent food wine with redcurrant, mint, spice and mineral aromas and smooth crisp finish.

Veenwouden - Paarl R415
The wine that put Veenwouden on the international wine map. Beautiful fleshy fruit with sumptuous folds of powdery tannins. A must for any discerning lover of wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon



Robertson - Robertson R32 R95
Smooth, full bodied style with rich mulberry, plum and cassis flavours supported by soft tannins.

Rietvallei - Robertson R48 R144
Wonderful full cassis on bitter chocolate platform. This wine is perfect as an everyday drink but will keep and reward the patient.

Warwick The First Lady - Stellenbosch R155
Named after founder and winemaker Norma Ratcliffe, the wine offers upfront blackberry fruit with fine wood integration,

Glen Carlou - Paarl R195
Ripe yet elegant cedary tannins sheating wonderfully integrated blackberry fruits. A sleeping beauty waiting to be discovered.

Rust en Vrede - Stellenbosch R350
A very elegant wine with huge tannin structure, lovely fruit and great mid palate weight. This spice oriented wine is supported by chocolate, tobacco and aniseed.



Pinotage



Beyerskloof - Stellenbosch

A smooth Pinotage with a ruby red colour. This wine is a complex with dark fruit and red cherry flavours and hints of oak aromas. A well structured and balanced wine with a smooth finish that could be enjoyed now or aged in the bottle for a few years.

Spier - Stellenbosch

Dark ruby in colour, the wine shows prominent plum and cherry on the nose with layers of vanilla and oak-derived aromas. An abundance of cherry and tobacco follows through to soft and fruity palate with a lingering aftertaste.

Barista - Paarl

A burst of intense, rich coffee and chocolate aromas with ripe nuances of mulberry, plum and Maraschino cherries. The sweet aromas of vanilla and banana follow through on the palate and create with the ripe, luscious tannins a wine ready to be enjoyed.

Robertson - Robertson

Matured in a combination of a French and American oak. Full bodied with rich, spicy black pepper flavours and delicious ripe plum.

Ripe, up-front, bursting with spice, black fruit and pepper. Rich and full bodied.

Boschendal 1685 - Franschhoek

Only the best grapes from the Boschendal vineyards were chosen for this wine. Made 100% from Shiraz grapes. This classic, spicy wine was matured in French barriques for 14 months and has excellent ageing potential. To be enjoyed with gammon and rare roast fillet.

Nederburg Manor House - Paarl

Dense ripe black fruit and wood spice with a firm structure, sinewy tannis and long finish.

Fryer's Cove - Bamboes Bay

At last a Pinot Noir with many of the classic strawberry fruit notes of a true burgundian style and with the truffles too! A great drink served lightly chilled at a summer's lunch.

R255

Muratic - Stellenbosch

SA's first Pinot Noir planted over 75 years ago. The nose shows gamey aromas with delicate redcurrant and strawberry fruit following through onto the palate. Complex yet elegant, this is one of the Cape's better Pinots.

De Wetshof Nature In Concert - Robertson

Spicy oak dominates underlying cherry and tobacco aromas.

Red Blends

- Graham Beck Railroad Red - *Franschhoek*** R108
The wine has a rich spicy Shiraz nose with layers of Cabernet berry flavours and subtle fruit tannins on the palate. A generous and rewarding red wine.
- Porcupine Ridge Syrah / Viognier - *Franschhoek*** R125
Rich, spicy flavours with hints of perfume on the nose following through on the palate. The wine is well balanced with intergrated oaking and soft tannins.
- Hartenberg Cabernet / Shiraz - *Stellenbosch*** R125
Juicy, full flavoured berry richness with a stylish, silky finish. Matured in small French barrels.
- Alto Rouge - *Stellenbosch*** R158
Full-bodied with tabacco, chocolate, toast and vanilla flavours combined with a good tannic structure, adding complexity and long maturation potential.
- Guardian Peak Frontier - *Stellenbosch*** R160
This wine shows great balance. The well intergrated tannins, elegant structure and a juicy finish make the Guardian Peak Frontier 2009 a very special wine.
- Kanonkop Kadette - *Stellenbosch*** R165
Spicy Pinotage / Cabernet / Merlot blends which is chunkily fruited.
- Rupert And Rothschild Classique - **Bordeaux Blend Style** *Paarl*** R225
Clean, fresh and focused with an abundance of red fruit flavour and vanilla spice. Floral notes run through the juice with plum and blueberry flavours leading to a soft and silky mouth feel.
- Warwick 3 Cape Ladies - *Stellenbosch*** R249
A great example of a Truly South African blend the components are Cabernet, Pinotage, Merlot and a touch of Shiraz. 'Sumptuous, well balanced'
- L'Ormarins Optima - *Franschhoek*** R335
A good blend of Cabernet, Merlot and Petit Verdot. Well weighted berry fruit amidst fine dry tannins with a sappy finish.
- Meerlust Rubicon - **Bordeaux Blend Style** *Stellenbosch*** R450
Intense, opaque ruby core with cerise rim. Powerful primary nose of black currant, cigar box, smoked meat and minerals promising long maturation potential. On the palate the wine shows remarkable approachability with intense dark fruit.

Ports And Dessert Wines

- De Krans Ruby N/V - *Calitzdorp*** R12 
Full bodied wine with powerful varietal flavours of bell pepper, green apple and freshly cut grass.
- De Krans Tawny - *Calitzdorp*** R18
Lovely coppery-gold colour. Flavours of coffee-toffee, hazelnut, cinnamon spice, as well as some raisins in the background. Good, long finish and excellent grip.
- De Krans Cape Vintage 2008 - *Calitzdorp*** R16
Juicy, full flavoured berry richness with a stylish, silky finish. Matured in small French barrels.
- Rietvallei Red Muscadel - *Robertson*** R10
A classic Red Muscadel and one of the Cape's most popular. Raisins and Rooibos with a touch of grapiness give this sweet rich desert wine great appeal.
- Ferreira Ruby Port - *Portugal*** R24
Young and fruity. Usually aged no more than three years. From Portugal.
